



ASIA/IRAQ – A Christian killed for his refusal to build silencers for firearms

Mosul (Agenzia Fides) - Laith Hadi Behnam was a 57-year-old and was a Christian of Syriac Orthodox confession of Mosul. On Wednesday 29 January, his unknown assassins killed him with a gun in his workshop located in the industrial area of al-Karama, in the western part of the city. According to the reconstruction provided by the website Syriac ankawa.com, the man was shot after his refusal to design and implement silencers to firearms.
